With a mammoth grid lining up each weekend, consistency is going to be key when it comes to the Mission Motorsport Caterham Seven 270R Championship and as it stands, Daniel Hope is the epitome of just that as the series rolls into Zandvoort.

Hope didn't win a race at the 2024 curtainraiser at Snetterton however a third and two fourth place finishes has given him a slender two-point lead heading into what promises to be an exciting event in the Netherlands.

Adding to his points tally will be the main focus for Hope this weekend however you can imagine that if a sniff of a win presents itself then he will look to snap it straight up; and the same can be said for Rrutuj Patki.

Patki bagged a brace of second place finishes last month and had it not been for an 11th in the finale he may well have been leading proceedings heading into this weekend.

Ryan Wilby and David Rooke are two other drivers that are striving for their first win of the year however given the evidence of both of their pace at Snetterton, they shouldn't have too long to wait.

Toby Ballard was a winner in Norfolk and buoyed by that success he'll be hoping for more as he set course for Europe ahead of Lyonel Tollemache, Rob Kennerley, Daniel Neale, Craig Boyle, Craig Storey and Harvey Lawrence

Two more winners from Snetterton, Nick Bryant and Ben Timmons, sit on the fringes of the top ten and they too will be worth casting an eye on as they bid to repeat their heroics from last month.

Is there anyone else to look out for? Well, Steve Merrit, Toby Boyes, Soloman Rogers and Louise Deason could all have their say up at the front; it's set to be a case of sit back, witness the unpredictability of the 270R Championship and enjoy the show.

Hot on the heels of a pulsating seasonopener at Snetterton in April, the popular one-make series ventures into mainland Europe to take centre stage at the home of the Formula 1 Dutch Grand Prix; and it's not to be missed.

Harry Cook, Hugo Bush and Lars Hoffman each claimed a win apiece last time out and the expectation is that all three drivers should be in the mix to add to their tallies in the delights of the Netherlands.

Virtue of his strong results in the two other races in Norfolk, Cook is the driver that arrives sitting at the summit of the points, however with the trio blanketed by just five points there is very little between them - so expect the gloves to be well and truly off.

Philip Bianchi trails Hoffman by a further five points and he'll be in high spirits having ended the opening weekend of the campaign on the third step of the podium.

Elsewhere, Ben Lopez-Appleton was a regular fixture inside the top six whilst the trio of Tom Wyllys, Duncan Mallet and David Yates also underlined their credentials as drivers to look out for as the season wears on.

Taylor O'Flanagan scored a third and a fourth at Snetterton however a non-finish means he heads to Zandvoort sitting ninth in the standings. Nevertheless, he will be one to definitely look out for as he bids to regain lost ground.

# EMERY OUT TO FURTHER ESTABLISH ROADSPORT REIGN

More than 40 cars lined up for the opening rounds of the Bilstein Caterham Roadsport Championship last month however there was one driver that ultimately stood head and shoulders above the rest, Jonathan Emery.

Emery was perfection personified at Snetterton to claim two commanding wins and as the series arrives at Zandvoort, all eyes are on the talented racer to see if he can maintain his 100% winning record.

The double race winner will undoubtedly be one of the favourites for glory, especially given the manner upon which he reigned supreme in Norfolk, with his victory in race one seeing him finish more than seven seconds clear of his nearest challenger.

Speaking of the challengers, with such a bumper grid there are plenty of drivers that will be eager to take the fight to Emery, not least the quartet of Paul Goldstein, Henry Morris, Istvan Demes and Monty Hinde - who complete the top five in the standings.

Ben Steward and Adam Kene produced strong performances to the start the year and they'll both be keen to close the gap to the front-runners. The same can be said for the likes of Jack English, Paddy Cunningham and Olly Brown too.

With such a rich entry list of talent, the roll call of drivers that could stake their claim towards the front of the field just goes on and on too.

Watchful eyes should be cast over Tim Payne, Django Jones, Will Jarvis, Barry Hanif, Neil Bell, Harvey Ashmore, Lee James, Henry Speeks, Andrew Myles and Giles Hanson - to name but a few.

Frenetic wheel-to-wheel entertainment has become a staple of the Bilstein Caterham Roadsport Championship and with another capacity grid poised for battle, that should be no different at Zandvoort this weekend.



Just two points separates the top two in the Vertex Caterham Seven UK Championship heading to the Netherlands this weekend and if last month's season-opener is anything to go by, Zandvoort is in prospect for a feast of blockbuster entertainment.

Reigning champion Lewis Thompson holds the advantage as it stands after kicking off the defence of his crown in superlative style with victory at Snetterton; and he'll be eager to add to his tally in mainland Europe.

Thompson was the class of the field in 2023 but on the evidence of the opening rounds, his quest to record back-to-back titles is something he will have to fiercely fight for especially as William Smith appears to have the bit between his teeth.

Smith got the better of Thompson to triumph in the remaining two races at Snetterton and he'll be eager to carry that momentum into this weekend's overseas trip.

Paul Donkin was another that starred at

the curtain-raiser as he tallied a brace of podiums and he, as well as Harry Senior and Carl Jones, will be worth keeping an eye on as they look to make their mark at the front of the field.

Other drivers that will look to build on their strong starts include Tim Dickens, Wes Payne, Justin Armstrong, Ben Simonds and Jake Swann; the quintet that currently complete the top ten in the championship standings.

Elsewhere, Tom Eden and Oliver Smith found themselves in the thick of the action a few weeks back while the likes of Chris Fraser, Matt Dyer and Ian Payne will be keen to make inroads to those that sit ahead of them in the points.

### All of the SIM Motorsport Caterham Graduates Championship drivers are looking forward to racing on the reworked Zandvoort circuit.

A change of tyres last year and a new layout (for us! We last visited in 2019) means new lap records are just waiting to be set, so bragging rights and podiums are both up for grabs.

CGRC is renowned for providing fair, close and competitive motorsport and this year looks to be no exception, with a combined 45+ car grid all jostling for the top step of the podium across both classes.

Last time out with the Sigma 135's at Brands there were no less than six drivers on the podium but it was Paul Goldstein (running, auspiciously, number 135!) who took overall championship points honours, with Alaric Barney and Thomas Gunter just one point behind

All three drivers will be aiming to do no less

this weekend as will the following pack of Armitage, Derry, Turner and Power and a number of guests from the Caterham 270R grid.

#### BLU

(Steady) Another competitor is close

**(Waved)** Another competitor is trying to pass.



#### YELLOW

**(Waved)** Danger ahead; no overtaking, slow down, be prepared to stop.

(**Double Waved**) Great danger ahead; no overtaking, slow down, be prepared to stop.



#### WHITE

Service vehicle or very slow car on circuit



YELLOW/RED STRIPES Slippery surface ahead.



#### **GREEN**

Proceed, hazard indicated has been cleared.



### **RED**

Stop Racing, proceed slowly to pits or startline as instructed by a marshal (at startline and individual marshal's posts). Race stopped.



#### **BLACK/ORANGE DISC**

Warning of mechanical failure which might not be obvious to the driver; call into pits immediately.



### **BLACK/WHITE DIAGONAL**

Warning to drivers that his/her behaviour (e.g corner cutting) is suspect and he/she may be black flagged.



### BLACK

Driver must call in immediately and report to the Clerk of the Course.



### **BLACK & WHITE CHEQUERED**

End of the race.
