

CTCRC Group A Race – Brands Hatch Circuit 29th & 30th JUNE 2024

ADDITIONAL SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

- 1. **Announcement:** The Classic Touring Car Racing Club Limited (CTCRC) will organise Group A Races to take place at Brands Hatch Circuit on 29^{th &} 30th June 2024. The races do not form part of a series or Championship (no points will be scored).
- 2. **Jurisdiction:** The event shall be held under the General Regulations of the Motorsport UK (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), the published Supplementary Regulations, these ASR's, the CTCRC Super Tourer general regulations and written instructions the organising club may issue for the event. The following also apply; the published Final Instructions, driver briefings and drivers' briefing notes, and bulletins issued at the event. See www.msvr.co.uk/car/events/2024/june/bh-30
- 3. **Eligible Competitors:** Drivers and Entrant Drivers must be members of the CTCRC and must be registered for the race. Each car may have a maximum of 1 driver per event.

4. Eligible Vehicles:

All eligible Group A touring cars as homologated for race use by FIA. All cars shall be prepared as in period and the specification will be approved by CTCRC competition secretary and eligibility team. The vehicles shall compete in 4 Classes which shall be:

Class A: For GPA cars up to 1800cc as produced for competition, and in accordance with CTCRC Super Tourer general regulations.

Class B: For cars from 1801cc – 2100cc as produced for competition, and in accordance with CTCRC Super Tourer general regulations.

Class C: For cars from 21001cc – 2600cc as produced for competition, and in accordance with CTCRC Super Tourer general regulations.

Class D: For cars above 2601cc as produced for competition, and in accordance with CTCRC Super Tourer general regulations.

NOTE: Motorsport UK equivalency factors for forced induction apply

For the duration of the events, all vehicles must comply with homologated technical details and general regulations for the cars permitted above, and those prescribed in the Motorsport UK Yearbook.

5. **Onboard Cameras:** Onboard cameras are mandatory in accordance with the relevant regulations referred to in CTCRC Championship regulations.
