Following receipt of a report from a Scrutineer / Eligibility Scrutineer / Technical Commissioner, I find that you are guilty of contravening regulation(s):

CR 5.15.2.1 i) - Only dry/slick tyres nominated for the event are allowed in the assembly area, pit lane or on track. If tyres which have not been nominated are found to be in the assembly area, pit lane or on track, the Competitor will be deemed to be in breach of these regulations and referred to the Clerk of the Course. If it is not possible to identify the owner of a tyre that has not been nominated it will be confiscated with the wheel to which it is fitted.

Additional Information / Reason(s) for Decision

Received a non-compliance report (reference Croft NC Car 210) from the eligibility scrutineer (Steven Fitzgerald 270899).

Tyre not nominated for the event (Tyre fitted to car on circuit). Video & Photographic evidence viewed

As a result, all laptimes are disallowed and car 210 is permitted to start from the back of the grid for race 1 & 2 with a 10 second delay

and therefore **C3.1.1**. Eligibility. Accordingly under **G5.3.1**, I order that you:

Be disqualified from the results of Practice (C.3.3)

If you are disqualified from the Race,

Be penalised under regulations **C3.5.1 (a) & (b)** - Mandatory

Be penalised under regulation **C3.5.1 (c)** - see Championship regulations

Be charged a fee in respect of costs in the sum of: £ **(C5.3.5.2)**

Competitors are reminded of the provisions of GR C1.1.13

No penalty points are recorded on your licence as a result of above

You are advised of your right of appeal.
