Additional Information / Reasons for Decision Investigation delayed due to other judicial and appeal issues. Marshal report shows that car 28 made contact with car 34 entering yellow flag zone. ITV footage reviewed which shows the contact. In car footage reviewed from car 28 which shows that car 28 had sufficient overlap on car 34 at the turn in point.
