

Q12.21.4 – Causing a collision, repetition of serious mistakes or the appearance of a lack of control over the						
car. Additional Information / Reasons for Decision:						
Held over from Saturday's final to Sunday.						
Following contact earlier in race car 85 was catching other cars. From behind car 94 he brushed contact across the bumper of 94 which caused car 94 to leave track. Reviewed in car footage and spoke to driver, who agreed what happened.

Additional Championship Penalty: CR4.2.3 100champ points and start next race from pit lane.

* If your practice times are dis-allowed above, you may, in accordance with Q12.9.4., start the race from the back of the grid with a mandatory 10 second delay or start from the pitlane on the first racing lap.
