**C2.3** – Gaining an unfair advantage (whether inadvertently or not)

Additional Information / Reasons for Decision:

Car 27 gained an unfair advantage at the hairpin which resulted in car 18 losing position in the race

Onboard footage of car 27, 18 & ITV viewed

Drivers of car 27, 18 and team entrants gave verbal evidence in the judicial hearing

Accordingly I order that you:

- Have the following qualifying lap times disallowed (Q12.27)
- Have the following race lap times disallowed (Q12.27)
- Be penalised by the addition of \_\_\_\_\_ to your elapsed race time (G5.3.7)
- Be penalised by the addition of <sup>3</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ position(s) to your race finishing position (G5.3.7)
- Be reported to the Stewards for alternative penalties (G5.3.7)
- No penalty points are recorded on your licence as a result of above
