

Following a hearing, I find that you are guilty of contravening Motorsport UK general regulation:

Q12.21.1 More than one change of direction to defend, failing to leave space to the edge of the track, manoeuvre likely to hinder others

In that you moved to the right into the Complex forcing car 18 to the edge of the track

Therefore, under GR G5.3 and CR4.2, I order that you should:

Х	Be verbally warned							
	Be officially reprimanded,							
	Be fined a sum of £ ,							
	Be penalised by the addition of seconds to your race time.							
	Be penalised by means of a place grid penalty							
	Be disqualified from the results of the qualifying / race for championship round							
	This is counted as a "strike", CR4.4.5, carrying a 3 place grid penalty							
0	Penalty points are awarded for this action, details of which will be recorded against your licence records. You are reminded of your right of appeal.
