Following a hearing and after viewing video evidence, I hereby find that you are guilty of contravening Motorsport UK general regulation:

C 2.3 Obtaining an unfair advantage (whether inadvertently or not)

In that you gained position on car 77 as a result of slight contact at the final corner

Therefore, under GR G5.3 and CR4.2, I order that you should be penalised:

By a verbal warning

By means of a one place penalty for the result of Championship round ...



By means of a 3 place grid penalty applied on the next Championship round that it can be taken



No penalty points are awarded for this action however, you are reminded of your right of appeal.

The decision above was announced verbally to the Competitor at the time and on the date indicated above.
