During any Qualifying Session .....At no time will any Car be allowed in the Pit Lane garages or Paddock areas until such time as that Qualifying Session has ended and the Car has cleared any Post-qualification Scrutineering checks by the Scrutineers and been released from Parc Fermé Conditions, except with the express permission of the Clerk of the Course and/or the Eligibility Scrutineer.

Accordingly under Motorsport UK Regulation **G5.3.3** I order

Car 123 fined £250 for breach of the above Championship Regulation.

Car 123 was observed exiting the pit lane into the paddock then re-entering the pitlane whilst the session was still in progress. The car then proceeded to Parc Ferme. At no time was anyone observed interfering the car.
