Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK NCR(s):

Ch.12 App.7 Art.1.8 Causing a collision, repetition of serious mistakes or the appearance of a lack of control over the car concerned

Brief Details:

Contact was made between Car #6 and Car #66 on the exit of the Esses.
Car #6 takes to a gap that is not great enough to get a car through without leaving the tarmac, and makes contact with the rear of #66 unsettling it, this contact could have been avoided by not going for the move. Both cars continued and finished the race.
