Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK NCR(s):

Ch.12 App.7 Art.1.8 Causing a collision, repetition of serious mistakes or the appearance of a lack of control over the car concerned

Brief Details:

Car 23 and 448 leave the circuit.

Video reviewed from 448 front and 23 front and rear. Driver of 23 and 448 interviewed. Entrant of 448 and parent of 23 present. Championship Safeguarding Officer present.

Car 23 and 448 are racing closely when car 23 begins to turn through the corner. Car 23 then changes gear and as they do so opens the steering angle. Due to the proximity of car 448 there was contact causing both to leave the circuit. Car 448 could have given more room however it was determined that car 23 was more at fault for opening the steering and knowing that car 448 was there.

Car 23 issued a verbal warning and reminded of their right to appeal.

Accordingly, under Motorsport UK NCR Ch.5A App.5 Art.2.3, I hereby order that you receive the following:

Verbal warning (Ch.2, App.2 Art 1 (a))
