Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK NCR(s):

Ch.12 App.7 Art.1.6 Use of track: exceeding track limits

### **Brief Details:**

Competitor breached track limits on a total of four (4) occasions, receiving the black/white flag after the second offence. The competitor passed the 5 second penalty board prior to the fourth offence, however after the fourth offence, there was not enough time to show the 10 second penalty board to the competitor prior to the end of the race.

### **Evidence Relied Upon:**

Circuit sensors and cameras

Accordingly, under Motorsport UK NCR Ch.5A App.5 Art.2.3, I hereby order that you receive the following:

Be penalised by the addition of time to your elapsed race time (Ch.2, Ann. A, Art. 1.3)

Additional Comments: Two penalties issued, one of five (5) seconds and one of ten (10) seconds which are added to your elapsed race time.

Any penalties applied will be recorded by Motorsport UK in accordance with NCR Ch.2 App.12 Art.1.1 (2.12.1.1).
